Minutes of a meeting of Yapham cum Meltonby Parish Council on 12th January 2015 in Yapham Village hall at 7.30pm

**Present:** Cllr P Arnold, Cllr P Bradley ( chairman), Cllr L Gray Cllr R O'Gram

Cllr Bradley welcomed everyone to the meeting.

**Public Session:** there were no members of the public wishing to speak

**1/16 Apologies:** apologies were received from Cllr K Moverley.

**2/16 To receive Declarations of Interest:** there were no declarations of interest.

**3/16 The minutes of the meeting held on 1st December 2015** were agreed as a true and accurate record and Cllr Bradley signed them as such on behalf of the council.

**4/16 To receive the clerk's report on matters being progressed from previous meetings.**

**Planning matters:** the clerk reported that a new enforcement officer had been appointed for this area.

**Public Transport Survey:** councillors were to distribute copies of the survey and a newsletter to all households. Where possible digital copies would be sent. Cllr Arnold was trying to compile an email list of parishioners so that it would be easier to communicate in the future.

**Neighbourhood Watch :** Cllr Bradley had received a telephone call, where the caller claimed to be ringing with regard to a motor accident from a year ago. This was a scam which she had reported via the action fraud website. Details of how to report fraud are included in the recent police bulletin.

**Data Protection:** advice had been received from ERNLLCA that Parish councils should be registered with the Information Commissioner as data handlers at a cost of £35 per year. Cllr Gray proposed and Cllr Bradley seconded and it was agreed that the clerk should register the Parish Council.

Cllr O'Gram reported that the road from Yapham Mill to Rowland Hill still had not been repaired. It was agreed that this should be followed up in spring.
